# Church Re-entry Guidelines

## No walking or talking during LIVE streaming

### COVID-19 Screening

- ◆ Everyone will enter the church through the front door. Upon entering, everyone must complete the CDC required screening by completing the questionnaire, temperature reading, and show proof of COVID-19 test results, if available.
- ◆ EVERYONE must wear a mask.
- ◆ Seating Assignments:
  - ◇ Couples and families seating will be on the left facing the pulpit
  - ◇ Individuals seating will be on the right facing the pulpit
- ◆ No socializing in the sanctuary.
- ◆ No one is allowed in the overflow or kitchen areas.

### Service Reminders

- ◆ Service is scheduled for one hour, for live streaming. If anyone desiring salvation, (water baptism, the infilling of the Holy Ghost) or placing your membership; they will be directed to sit on the front row after dismissal. Individual counseling for salvation will be done after service to visitors only.
- ◆ Baptism will be schedule by appointment.
- ◆ No one is to sit in the pulpit or the choir stands until further notice.
- ◆ If anyone needs counseling by the Pastor.
  - ◇ Call and make an appointment
  - ◇ No Counseling will be done on Sunday morning
  - ◇ No one is to enter Pastors office without an appointment
