FASTING

January 1—January 31, 2020

Our Annual Fast begins on Tuesday, December 31, 2019 at 12 am and will conclude on Friday, January 31, 2020 at 4 pm. Remember that our fast begins every night at 12 am, at which time, we will abstain from food, television (except for Gospel radio and television) and sex until the time our fast ends on that particular day. Participants are encouraged to drink water daily throughout our entire fast. Those persons who take prescribed medication must obey the advice of your physician and follow your diet, pray and study with us from the Word of God.

Week 1:

No food. Water only from 12 am to 12 noon.

Week 2:

No food. Water only from 12 am to 4 pm. Eat light after 4 pm.

Week 3:

No food. Water only from 12 am to 4 pm. Eat only soups and salads after 4 pm.

Week 4:

No food. Water only from 12 am to 4 pm. Eat only fruits after 4 pm. Optional for Week 4: total abstinence for 24 hours for those who can endure.)

November 2020 - Jacobs Ladder Community Fellowship Marriage Seminar and Luncheon, Inglewood, California - *"It's A Family Affair"*


